

The U.S. Army Communications-Electronics Life Cycle Management Command (C-E LCMC) S3 multiple award contracts were awarded on March 7, 2006. These contracts, executed by the C-E LCMC Acquisition Center in support of the Fort Monmouth Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C4ISR) provide a multiple award vehicle covering a broad range of life cycle services designed to efficiently meet the integrated engineering, business operations and logistics service needs of all C4ISR customers. The contracts provide access to multiple prime contractors and subcontractors to support the broad range of life cycle services required to fulfill varied user demands. These demands may require services and incidental equipment to facilitate support to the Government in the area of engineering, business operations and logistics. These services may be performed in conjunction with any/all new and existing C4ISR system of systems, family of systems, platforms, systems, subsystems and items. The total estimated value of the S3 is \$19.25 billion over ten years. The contracts consist of a 5-year base ordering period and one 5-year option. Seven (7) prime contract awards were made to include three (3) awards to small business concerns. Of the three (3) small business awards, two (2) went to small businesses (one of which is also an SBA certified small disadvantaged business) and one (1) to an 8(a) company that is also a service-disabled veteran-owned small business.
